Project Summary: Substance Assistance For Elders (SAFE) Project

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Target Population: The SAFE project aims to target older (55+) individuals residing in the

greater Los Angeles area, identified as having risky substance use behaviors and willing to

discuss these behaviors with a qualified professional. These individuals may also be disabled,

dual-eligible, and/or require caregiver support.

Project Overview: Through Independence at Home (IAH), a division of SCAN Health Plan,

the SAFE project will implement education and early interventions for older adults residing in

the community with identified substance misuse and abuse issues. A combination of face-to-face

and telephonic outreach will address a growing trend of substance use amongst this population.

Services would be no cost to the individual and available in both English and Spanish.
